Voluntary assisted dying resources for residential aged care

Voluntary assisted dying (VAD) is operating in all Australian States and will start in the Australian Capital Territory on 3 November 2025. Residential aged care facilities will need to be prepared for what this will mean for them, their staff, and the residents in their care.
