

Voluntary assisted dying resources for residential aged care.

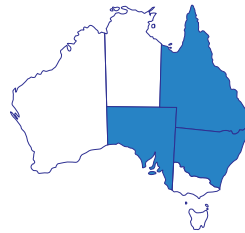

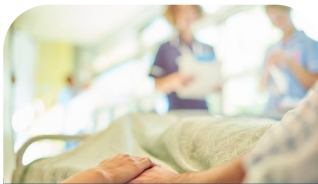

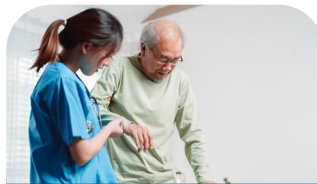
