## How can I localise or update my palliative care HealthPathways?

The HealthPathways section of the Primary Care toolkit has been designed to support primary care providers in navigating to local HealthPathways; and also to support HealthPathways teams in the development of palliative care and advance care planning HealthPathways.

HealthPathways provide concise, relevant and evidenced-based information on the assessment and management of common conditions and symptoms, as well as providing localised referral pathways for accessing services and specialist care. They use a web-based information portal and are designed for use by healthcare workers at the point of care.

The HealthPathways section of the Primary Care toolkit contains:

- Information on accessing local HealthPathways;
- Mapping of Australian HealthPathways in palliative care and advance care planning;
- Information on how HealthPathways are developed; and
- Resources for HealthPathways development.
